Directors' Reports

Students have voted on the 2022 trip – Orlando, Florida. Propose May 25-29, 2022. Still needs to be approved by board and superintendent. Working with Travel with Barb, all payments will be done online again through credit or debit card.

Jazz Band trip on May 29, 2021. Information sent to parents and kids recently. Parents will be able to help with driving. Will need an equipment van.

Final concert is May 10th. Leadership and colorguard tryouts are May 12th at 7pm. Working with Katrina to run both at same time at high school.

Hired a new drum line instructor: Jacob Dill. Lots of students trying out for drum line.

School will be asking for “holds” to be submitted especially for seniors who have not paid for rental fees. Other grades will follow within 1-2 weeks.

Districts on May 23rd. Received 5 excellent and 21 superior ratings. More kids were able to participate because of how it was organized.

- UNL spring game concessions – 16 signed up. Will be spread out over 4 stands.
- Ford Drive for Your School – trying to contact about this summer or fall
- Bug Butter – hold off for now, maybe reconsider next fall
- Apparel fundraiser – no discussion in recent months; Kelli can help if we want to pursue; consider Waverly blankets in the fall and offer to audience beyond band, likely to be broad interest

Have Band Boosters sponsored a scholarship? Sent drum majors to a leadership camp several years ago. No scholarship for graduating seniors.

Other golden account fundraisers since it will be a trip year? Have done poinsettias in the past, consider Village Pie Maker. Deposit for June 1st, total cost: \$1,994/person. Consider painting street numbers on curbs (Viking, W). Consider carwash and participants split the money.
